- •MEASURE 102 & MEASURE 26-199 (Yes to Affordable Housing) Funds and renovates homes for up to 7,500 people in need and lifts barriers to affordable housing.



- •MEASURE 103 Using the bogeyman of a grocery tax—which doesn't exist—this deceptive measure sticks a tax loophole in the Oregon Constitution to protect big corporations. Permanently.
- •MEASURE 104 Requires a supermajority to pass any legislation that raises revenue, protecting tax perks for the rich and threatening funding for schools and healthcare.
- •MEASURE 105 Removes Oregon's sanctuary status, which would encourage racial profiling of immigrants and divert local police funding to federal law enforcement.
- •MEASURE 106 Cuts access to abortion services for hundreds of thousands of low-income women and public employees.
